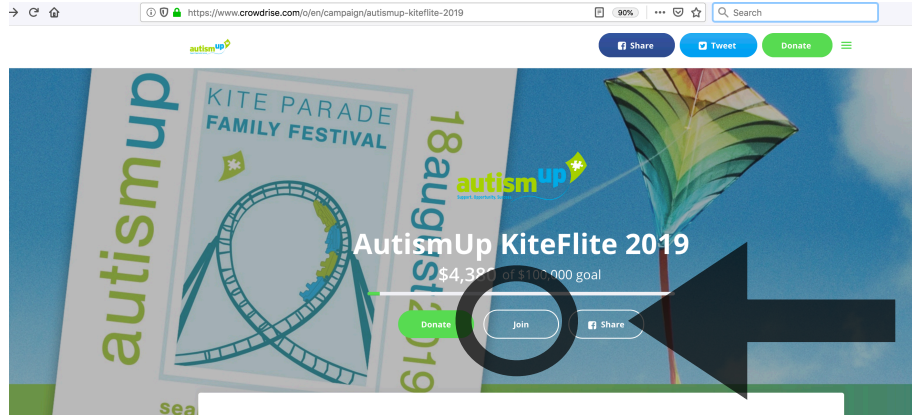



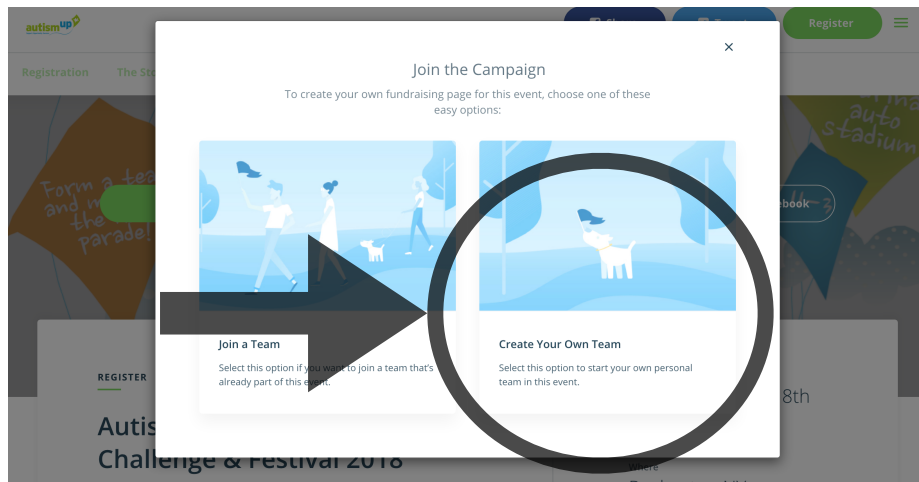
STEPS TO FORM A KITE FLITE TEAM

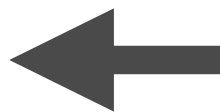
